## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

1. All players must read and understand the terms and conditions of the tournament and sign the registration forms.
2. All teams must provide a designated home ground and alternative for the group stages and knockout stages of the tournament
3. All teams must adhere to the rules and regulations of the tournament. Teams flouting these rules and regulations will automatically be disqualified from the tournament.
4. No player will play for more than one team during the preliminary stage of the tournament. All players will only play under their registered teams. Any player switching teams after the preliminary stages must inform the organisers.
5. No National Super League or Kenyan Premier League players will be allowed to participate in the tournament.
6. All players must be born between 1<sup>st</sup> January, 1998 and 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2001 inclusive.
7. Dully filled registration forms must be submitted together with copies of either NATIONAL I.D, PASSPORT or SCHOOL ID (ONLY FOR THOSE UNDER 18) for each player. Teams submitting registration forms without photocopies of identification documents will be DISQUALIFIED.
8. Any player producing a student ID card may also be required to produce a National Identity card if he/she is above 18 years.
9. Clinic Cards, School IDs without school stamps, Baptismal Cards, School leaving Certificates, National ID Waiting Cards are not acceptable. Organizers will only consider National ID Cards and valid passports (not expired).
10. If none of the above documents are available, then participation will be at organizers' discretion.
11. On the day of the tournament, each player will be required to produce ORIGINALS of the photocopied identification documents submitted with the registration form. Failure to do so will result in the player being disqualified from participating in the tournament.
12. Teams will be responsible for their internal affairs. Disputes within the teams, that jeopardize the credibility of the tournament may lead to automatic disqualification from the tournament.
13. Participating teams will not hold the organiser responsible for any injuries, losses or any damages during the tournament.
14. Participating teams and all their members exclusively authorize the organisers to use their teams' name or individuals on promotions and advertisements before, during and after tournament.
15. All players must agree to random drug tests during the duration of the entire tournament. Appropriate action will be taken by organisers on players whose results are positive, or who will fail to show up for the test at the designated place and time.
16. In the event of violence, or any form of hooliganism from fans/spectators, team members or team officials, the event organisers reserve the right to disqualify the responsible team.
17. All players must be of good health and medically fit to participate in the tournament.
18. The organisers reserve the right to change rules of participation without prior notice. In case of any disputes arising, the organisers' decision will be final.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Any player receiving a red card will be suspended from the following match.
2. Any player who receives 2 red cards during the tournament will be suspended for the next 3 matches .
3. Any player who accumulates three yellow cards in successive matches will be suspended from participating in the next match.
4. Cards received during the preliminaries will be waived once the team qualifies for the regional finals. Cards received during the regional finals will be waived once the team qualifies for the National finals.



- Any team that fields a player not registered and approved by the organiser will be disqualified from the tournament.
- Teams will be required to observe high standards of discipline. Any form of violence/incitement from players, officials or fans will lead to a total ban on the team concerned.
- Any protests must be made in writing to the match officials prior to kick off and signed by captains of both teams. In case the captain of the accused team declines to sign, the match officials must indicate so and sign.
- Any appeals must be made within 24 hours of group matches and 1 hour of knockout matches and addressed to the tournament Independent Disciplinary Appeals Committee (IDAC). Teams can appeal IDAC decisions to the tournament Appeals Committee. The Appeals Committees' decision is final and teams agree not to pursue the matter further in any other avenues.
